Dear Parent/Carer

Year 9 will take part in activities this year from 15<sup>th</sup>- 19<sup>th</sup> July. Your child has a number of options that they can choose from.

### Alternative Sports - £70

This activity will include trips to Telford Ski Centre, Kingswinford Golf Centre and Top Barn (canoeing & raft building), along with time in school playing the likes of dodgeball and Danish long ball.

### Media & Creative Arts Week - £155

This activity will involve students visiting two attractions: Harry Potter Studio & A West End Show in London. There will be a number of activities, which will include helping students to use a range of skills and technology to create their own music video. This also includes The Chocolate Film Company working with the students in school to produce a music video.

### Humanities Week - £70

This week will focus on local history and geography and includes trips to RAF Cosford, The Black Country Living Museum, Birmingham Museum & Sea Life Centre and Kinver Rock Houses. Students will have organised tours and activities at the museums and a guided tour of Kinver Rock Houses from a local expert.

### Science Week - £40

This will include a trip to The Science Museum, a forensic science day, a 'Horrible Science' day and a Science Fiction day. Students will have the opportunity to take part in different experiments throughout the week.

Please be aware that these prices are as accurate as they can be at this stage and the **cost may increase or decrease slightly** depending on how many students opt for each activity. Some of the activities may have limited places so we cannot guarantee that your child will get their preferred activity – but we will try our best to ensure that students get their choice where possible.

We would be grateful if you could complete the form to **indicate which activity your child would like to take part in by Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April**. Please hand in this form to your child's form tutor. This will enable the staff running the individual activities to then give you a final cost of the activity before deposits need to be paid. A full itinerary, consent forms and medical forms for each activity will be given to your child once their place has been confirmed.
