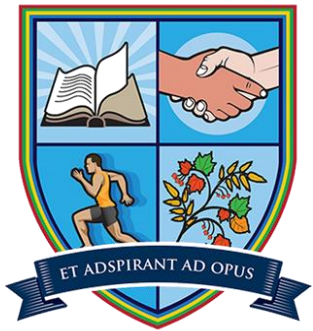

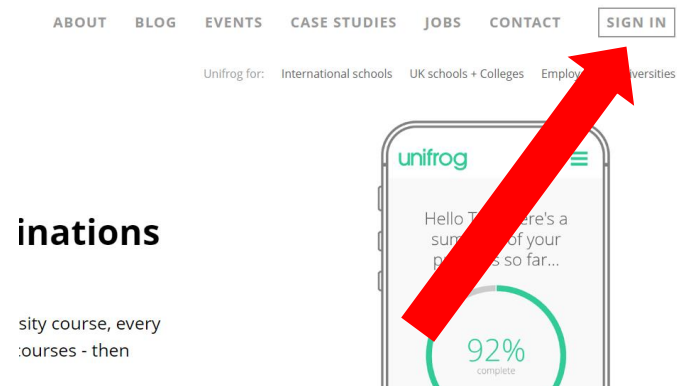
Work Experience – Virtual Tasks
