1. Aims

Our Uniform Policy aims to:

- Set out our approach to requiring a uniform that is of reasonable cost and offers the best value for money for parents and carers
- Explain how we will avoid discrimination in line with our legal duties under the Equality Act 2010
- Clarify our expectations for school uniform in each of our schools

2. Our legal duties under the Equality Act 2010

The <u>Equality Act 2010</u> prohibits discrimination against an individual based on the protected characteristics, which include sex, race, religion or belief, and gender reassignment.

To avoid discrimination, our schools will:

- Avoid listing uniform items based on sex, to give all pupils the opportunity to wear the uniform they feel most comfortable in or that most reflects their self-identified gender
- Make sure that our uniform costs the same for all pupils within each school
- Allow all pupils to have long hair (though we reserve the right to ask for this to be tied back)
- Allow all pupils to style their hair in a way that meets with the schools' expectations as detailed yet makes them feel most comfortable and complies with health and safety requirements
- Allow pupils to request changes to swimwear for religious reasons
- Allow pupils to wear headscarves and other religious or cultural symbols
- Allow for adaptations to our policy on the grounds of equality by asking pupils or their parents to get in touch with the relevant staff member in school who can answer questions about the policy and respond to any requests

3. Limiting the cost of school uniform

Our schools have a duty to make sure that the uniform we require is affordable, in line with statutory guidance from the Department for Education on the cost of school uniform.

We understand that items with distinctive characteristics (such as branded items, or items that have to have a school logo or a unique fabric/colour/design) cannot be purchased from a wide range of retailers and that requiring many such items limits parents' ability to 'shop around' for a low price.

We will make sure our uniform:

- Is available at a reasonable cost
- Provides the best value for money for parents/carers

We will do this by:

- Carefully considering whether any items with distinctive characteristics are necessary
- Limiting any items with distinctive characteristics where possible or providing more affordable purchase options such as through pre-owned uniform sales
- Limiting items with distinctive characteristics to low-cost or long-lasting items, such as ties
- Considering cheaper alternatives to school-branded items
- Avoiding specific requirements for items pupils could wear on non-school days, such as coats, bags and shoes

- Keeping the number of optional branded items to a minimum, so that the school's uniform
 can act as a social leveler or providing more affordable purchase options such as through
 pre-owned uniform sales
- Avoiding different uniform requirements for different year/class/house groups
- Avoiding different uniform requirements for extra-curricular activities
- Considering alternative methods for signaling differences in groups for interschool competitions, such as creating posters or labels
- Making sure that arrangements are in place for parents to acquire pre-owned uniform items
- Avoiding frequent changes to uniform specifications and minimising the financial impact on parents of any changes

4. Expectations for our school communities

Pupils

Pupils are expected to wear the correct uniform at all times (other than specified non-school uniform days) while:

- On the school premises
- Travelling to and from school
- At out-of-school events or on trips that are organised by the school, or where they are representing the school (if required)

Pupils are also expected to contact relevant staff member in school if they want to request an amendment to the uniform policy in relation to their protected characteristics.

Parents and carers

Parents and carers are expected to make sure their child has the correct uniform and PE kit, and that every item is:

- Clean
- Clearly labelled with the child's name
- In good condition

Parents are also expected to contact the relevant staff member in school if they want to request an amendment to the uniform policy in relation to:

- Their child's protected characteristics
- The cost of the uniform

Parents are expected to lodge any complaints or objections relating to the school uniform in a timely and reasonable manner.

Disputes about the cost of the school uniform will be dealt with in accordance with our trust's complaints procedure.

Staff

Staff will closely monitor pupils to make sure they are in correct uniform. They will give any pupils and families breaching the uniform policy the opportunity to comply, but will follow up with the headteacher if the situation doesn't improve.

Ongoing breaches of our uniform policy will be dealt with in accordance with the school's positive conduct policy.

In cases where it is suspected that financial hardship has resulted in a pupil not complying with this uniform policy, staff will take a mindful and considerate approach to resolving the situation.

Trustees

The trust board will review this policy and make sure that it:

- Is appropriate for each school's context
- Is implemented fairly across each school
- Takes into account the views of parents and pupils
- Offers a uniform that is appropriate, practical and safe for all pupils

The board will also make sure that the school's uniform supplier arrangements give the highest priority to cost and value for money, for example by avoiding single supplier contracts and by retendering contracts at least every 5 years.

This policy will be reviewed and approved by the trust board every three years. Where there are proposed significant changes to the uniform policy we will consult with parents.

Uniform expectations – secondary

Uniform expectations – secondary				
Main uniform	 A school blazer must be worn at all times. The blazer must be worn correctly and sleeves cannot be rolled up. The school badge must be clearly visible on the tie at all times. The top button of the shirt must be done up. Fashion shirts and polo shirts are not permitted. Trousers must be full-length, plain and of a tailored, smart style with no decorative buttons or zips. Leggings, jogging bottoms, cuffed ankles, denim or cord type or figure-hugging trousers are not permitted. Only plain black belts are permitted to be worn with trousers. Skirts must be knee length, tailored and not made of Lycra, elasticated or jersey type material. Skirt styles should be in-line with the individual school expectation. Any clothing worn underneath school uniform must not be visible. 			
Shoes, bags and coats	 Shoes must be plain, polishable black, smart and practical and must not have any visible logos. Boots, canvas shoes nor trainers of any kind are not permitted. Plain socks or tights must be worn with all shoe types. Shoe styles should be in-line with the individual school expectation. Bags must be of a suitable size to carry exercise books/A4 folders and appropriate for use within the school. Fashion bags and handbags are not permitted. Coats should be plain in colour and in a style suitable for school. Denim jackets, leather jackets and tracksuit tops are not permitted and hooded sweaters and cardigans should not be substituted for a coat. Coats, jackets and hoodies are not allowed to be worn at any time in the school building. 			
Jewellery	 A pair of small plain stud earrings (one in each ear lobe) is permitted. Hoops are not permitted. Earrings must be removed for all physical activity. Other piercings such as nose studs, rings, or facial piercings are not permitted. Any such piercings will need to be removed. Ear stretchers, flesh tunnels and flesh plugs are not permitted. One signet ring or similar and a watch may be worn. No other jewellery or fashion accessories are permitted. 			

Hairstyles	 Hair must be cut and styled in an appropriate manner that is suitable for a formal educational and professional environment. Hair must not be dyed an unnatural or extreme colour, extreme length changes or tramlines are not permitted. Hair bands and scrunchies should complement the colours of the school uniform.
Make Up	 Any make up worn must be discreet. False eyelashes are not permitted. False nails and nail extensions of any description are not permitted. Nail varnish must be clear or nude. Neon colours, glitter or embellishments are not permitted.
